Managers - Please find referee at least 15 minutes prior to match and provide him with MSSF Match Report, rosters, laminated player's cards (WITH PLAYER PICTURE ON CARD), and game fees to avoid delaying the start of the match.

TEAMS PLAYING UP MUST PAY THE REF FEES OF THE DIVISION THEY ARE PLAYING IN For example if you are a U10 team playing in the U11 9v9 division, then you must pay the half of \$54 THIS ALSO APPLIES TO THE SPECIAL SITUATIONS IN THE OLDER AGE GROUPS EXAMPLES BELOW

EXAMPLES:

SPECIAL SITUATION Example 1: U16 vs U17, they pay the refs \$75/\$65/\$65 and play 45 min halfs.

Example 2: U15 or U16 vs U17, they want to play 40 min halfs, they STILL pay refs \$75/\$65/\$65 regardless

Example 3: U15 vs U15 or U16, they play 40 min halfs and pay refs \$65/\$50/\$50 Example 4: U14 vs U15, they pay the refs \$65/\$50/\$50 and play 40 min halfs

Example 5: U14 vs U15, they want to play 35 min halfs, they STILL pay refs \$65/\$50/\$50 regardless

Each team pays one-half of the Referee fee and one of the Assistant Referee fees.

If only two referees are present, each team pays one-half of the Referee and one-half of the Assistant Referee fee.

If only one referee is present, each team pays one-half of the Referee fee.

Referees do not receive any additional fees if a referee is missing.

Club linesmen may be used at the discretion of the Referee. They will be under direct supervision of the Referee.

Club linesmen, even though a licensed USSF Referee, may only indicate ball out of touch, and may not call fouls or offsides.

Club linesmen are not to receive compensation for their services.

Club linesmen are not to be used for small-sided matches.

Referee fees are to be paid prior to the commencement of the match.

If a match is cancelled due to weather prior to halftime, the referees are to receive one-half of the match fees.

If a match is canceled in the second half, referees are to receive their full match fees.
